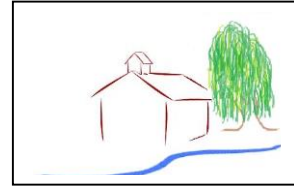

Camp Rules and Expectations

Schoolhouse Rules and Behavior Management:

Schoolhouse rules (listed below) are designed to facilitate a safe and productive learning environment for all stakeholders in our summer camps. In the event a rule is broken, consequences may include verbal redirection, parent contact, or dismissal from the camp, depending upon the infraction.

1. Honor the rights and responsibilities of others.
2. Respect the property of others.
3. Obey the rules of specific areas.
4. Arrive on time and be prepared.

Arrival and Departure:

Campers are expected to arrive, and depart, within 15 minutes of the designated camp start and end times. Unauthorized early arrivals or delayed departures may result in dismissal from the camp.

Payment Policies:

Payment (\$150 per camp) is due by 8:50 am on the first day of camp. Personal checks are accepted, and should be made out to *The Learning Barn*. There will be a \$30 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued following the start of a camp.

Camp Activities:

Camp activities posted on the school webpage are contingent upon weather conditions, student interest, and serendipity. Alterations to the anticipated offerings may occur.

Lunch:

Students are expected to bring a bag lunch each day of camp. Refrigerator and water fountains will be available.

Willow Creek Farm Grounds and Animals:

The animals on our farm are very dear to us, and we will visit with them as part of our planned learning experiences. In fact, students are encouraged to bring rubber mud boots, or “play shoes,” to camp for farm adventures. However, to maintain everyone’s safety and comfort, please respect the guidelines for entering the animals’ designated areas. ***Visitors MUST be accompanied by the teacher to visit any farm area outside of the school yard, or to interact in any way with the animals.***
